Application Requirements

- Subject Line: Star Community Health Scholarship
- Include the following: name, current high school, college/university you plan to attend Fall of 2026, intended major/area of study and future career goals
- Essay, 1-2 pages: **What does health mean to you, and how does it impact the trajectory of your life?**
- One letter of recommendation from a teacher or community leader

Additional Details:

- Scholarship recipients will need to submit a W9 form to receive the check.
- Star Community Health will host a small reception in April for the five winners and their families.
- The shadowing experience will take place late June or early July of 2026. Students are expected to provide immunization records and other medical clearances. More information to come once selected.
